All NHS members must complete a total of **45** community service hours by April 6th of their senior year. They may choose to get all of their hours completed within one calendar year and work toward a variety of Presidential Service Awards (see the NHS website) or pace their volunteer service to meet the 45 hour requirement. Honorary designation is awarded at the mandatory awards ceremony in May for those students who complete more than 100 hours of service throughout their high school career.



Only recognized, established institutions and organizations are approved as sites for community service (i.e. non-profit organizations, schools, libraries, hospitals, nursing homes, churches, social service agency, environmental stewardship, community service groups, etc.) View a complete list on the BHS Community Service Website. Remember, service that benefits you in any way will **NOT** count toward your hours. See the NHS website to verify your hours and get prior approval from Mrs. Moore before volunteering.
